Charleston Symphony Youth Strings Requirements

1. **Scale Requirements:** select one major and one minor scale (minimum 2 octaves):

- C Major, G Major, D Major, A Major, F Major
- C melodic minor, D melodic minor
 - Scales prepared at 72 beats per min:
 - One quarter per note – detached bow



- Four quarters per note – spiccato (middle of bow)



- Pattern: one quarter and two eights



2. **Solo Excerpt:** please prepare a 3-minute (maximum) excerpt from a solo work of your choice. Must be Suzuki Book 3+ or equivalent.

3. **Orchestral Excerpt:**

- Brandenburg Concerto No. 3 arr. Merle Isaac m. 54-87
- Star Spangled Banner beginning to end
